and to the Holy Spirit:**

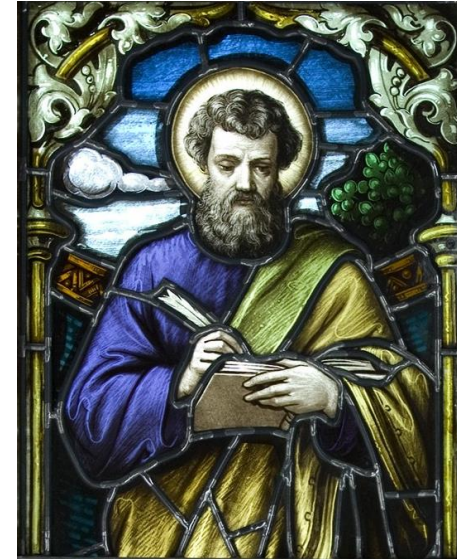
