and 'to the 'Holy 'Spirit:

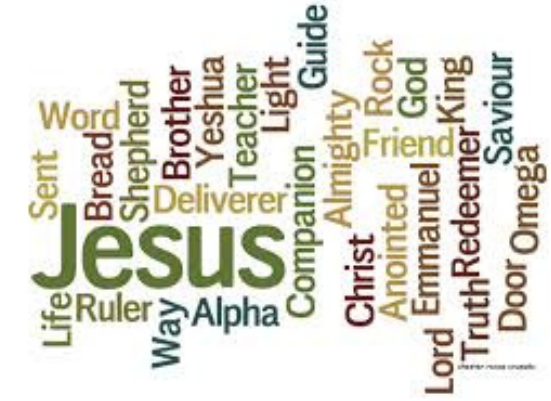
