Notice is hereby given that a **SPECIAL VESTRY meeting** of the parish of St. Barnabas will be held on

Sunday, MAY 25th, 2014 at 12:00 p.m./noon in the Church

Given the urgency, broad extent, and estimated high cost of repairs necessary to the exterior structural walls and brickwork of the sanctuary, as made evident by the investigations undertaken by the Repair Task Force

and

given the lack of feasibility of less expensive alternative or phased approaches to these necessary repairs:

a Special Vestry meeting will be held, with the following purpose: to decide whether to—

begin these major repairs during the spring and summer of 2014

or

disband the Repair Task Force, with thanks for the comprehensive information they have provided, and authorize the Corporation to undertake only such repairs as are necessary to ensure the building can be used safely in the short-term, while other options for the future of the parish are being considered.

It is understood that the decision to authorize such short-term repairs only is an irreversible decision. It means that the current St. Barnabas building will eventually be either sold or demolished. St. Barnabas parish could use the resulting monies to relocate (to a near-by existing building) or redevelop (a new, smaller structure on this site).


A two-thirds majority will be required to make this decision.
